Question 1

Prove that the graphoid properties are satisfied if we interpret $(X \perp\!\!\!\perp Y|Z)$ to mean “all paths from a subset X of nodes to a subset Y of nodes are intercepted by a subset Z of nodes.”

Question 2

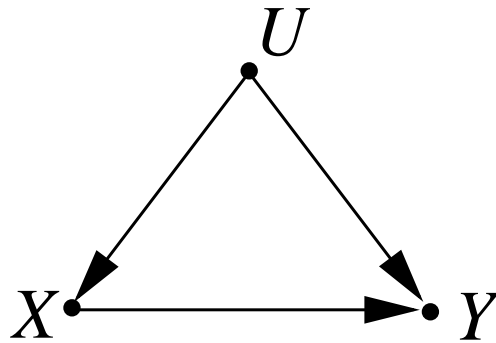


Figure 1: Bayesian network

Given this fragment of a Bayesian Network, in Figure 1, add two variables to the network, Z and W , such that the following three conditions hold simultaneously:

- Z and X are dependent given W , and
- Z and U are independent given W .
- Z and W are ancestors of Y but not of X .
